Include with it the following items:

A cover letter detailing what the candidate hopes to accomplish during the Fellowship, listing areas of particular interest and future career and/or educational goals

A sample of the applicant's writing and research abilities that treats a topic relevant to the Galbraith Fellowship Program areas of concern

Two letters of reference from individuals who can discuss the applicant's interests, qualifications, and ability to communicate effectively — both orally and in writing. The letters should include the name, address, office and home phone numbers, and e-mail address of the individual providing the reference.

A complete, official college transcript for both undergraduate and any graduate study.

A full resume detailing education, employment experience and relevant extra-curricular or community activities.

Any other material the candidate may feel helpful in advancing the application.

Application Deadline: Six weeks prior to desired start date but you are encouraged to submit as soon as possible.
